Math Programs

Sum It Up math programs allow children entering grades 1-6 to review concepts covered during the school year and to preview new material for the coming fall. Whether your child needs to review and maintain skills or is skipping a level in math, our math program has a class for your child!

Each week will focus on a particular content area such as fractions, geometry, and computation. In small, non-competitive group settings, students will use manipulatives, problem solving strategies, games, and group discussion to generate an understanding of math.

For each class session, students will receive a work packet which contains work completed in class and a resource page with vocabulary & explanations that students can use as a reference. In addition, optional "at home" practice will be given so that parents can reinforce concepts at home.
