Math Programs

Sum It Up general math programs allow children entering grades K-8 to review concepts covered during the school year and to preview new material for the coming fall. Each week will focus on a particular content area such as fractions, geometry, and computation. In small, non-competitive group settings, students will use manipulatives, problem solving strategies, games, and group discussions to generate an understanding of math.

For each class session, students will receive a work packet which contains work completed in class and a resource page with vocabulary & explanations that students can use as a reference. In addition, "at home" practice will be given so that parents can reinforce concepts at home.
